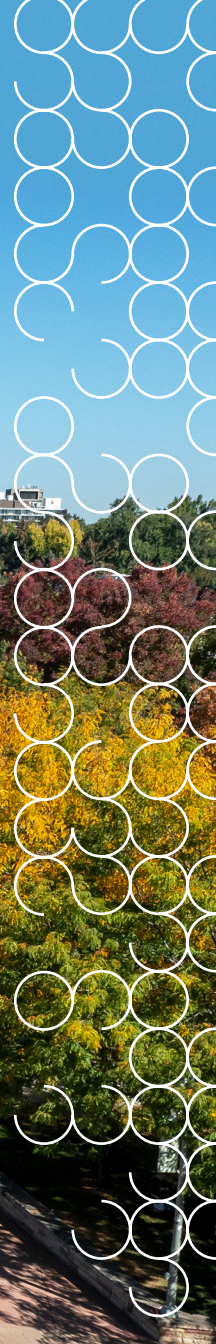

## PROGRAMS FOR LEARNING ACADEMIC AND COMMUNITY ENGLISH (PLACE)

Students needing additional English language and academic preparation can attend one of the PLACE programs found below:

### INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM

An English program for students who wish to enroll at a U.S. institution, but need additional English language support and instruction.

### BRIDGE PROGRAMS

An academic program which combines English language coursework with degree-seeking coursework. These programs are intended only for graduate students in select degree seeking programs.

### COMMUNITY AND CUSTOMIZED GROUP PROGRAMS

Innovative, customized language and cultural programs that are designed in partnership with specific local and international communities. PLACE is located on campus and offers additional support to help you adapt to U.S. university life, including:

- Personalized academic, language and cultural support
- Conversation Partners programs to practice English outside the classroom
- Social activities
- Test preparation classes
- Global Village living and learning community where International Year One students are brought together

## APPLYING TO CSU

#### + PROCESSING FEE

Submit non-refundable \$50<sup>2</sup> processing fee or approved fee waiver.

#### + TOEFL, IELTS, OR DUOLINGO RESULTS

For direct admission, submit your official scores for the English language test. \*Note: Graduate school does not accept Duolingo.

#### + OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS/CREDENTIALS

Submit your official transcript in the original language and in a certified literal English translation.

#### + RELEVANT TEST SCORES

SAT is not required for undergraduate admission. Graduate programs may have different testing requirements.<sup>3</sup>

#### + A STATEMENT OF PURPOSE/PERSONAL STATEMENT

Demonstrate the unique value you will bring to our incoming class.<sup>4</sup>

#### + PROOF OF FINANCES

In order to receive immigration documents you will need to provide financial proof for one year of study.\*

#### + PASSPORT INFORMATION PAGE

Submit a copy of your picture/biographical page of your passport.\*
