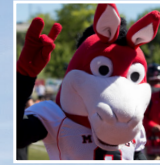

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

ACADEMIC RECORDS

Submit official academic records from all secondary and post-secondary schools you have attended outside the U.S., whether or not you earned a degree, certificate or diploma.

Submit transcripts by uploading an unofficial copy to the student application portal. All transcripts must be translated into English.

Before you can enroll, official transcripts must be submitted to the GISS office.

GRADUATE PROGRAM ADMISSION

Many graduate programs require standardized tests, such as the GRE or GMAT. Some require a minimum GPA, letters of recommendation, a statement of purpose or other materials. Please visit ucmo.edu/masters to review our graduate catalog and learn about a particular graduate program's minimum admission requirements.

ADMISSION DEADLINES

Apply for admission and submit required supporting materials as early as possible. The deadlines for admission are:

- Fall - July 1 (July 15 if applying for admission from within the USA)
- Spring – October 15th (December 1st if applying for admission from within the USA)
- Summer – April 1st (May 1 if applying for admission from within the USA)

If you are unable to meet the minimum test score, you will be admitted to UCM if you meet the academic requirements; however, you will be processed as an Intensive English Program student and enrolled in English as a second language courses until you demonstrate English language proficiency.

5. IN DEMAND MAJORS

UCM's two most popular graduate degree programs selected by our international students are Computer Science AND Computer Information Systems & Information Technology. Both of these programs provide students with a 35-40 percent discount in tuition and require only 30 semester hours to complete. Both programs are also STEM designated, which allows extended work opportunities for students in the U.S. after completing degree requirements.

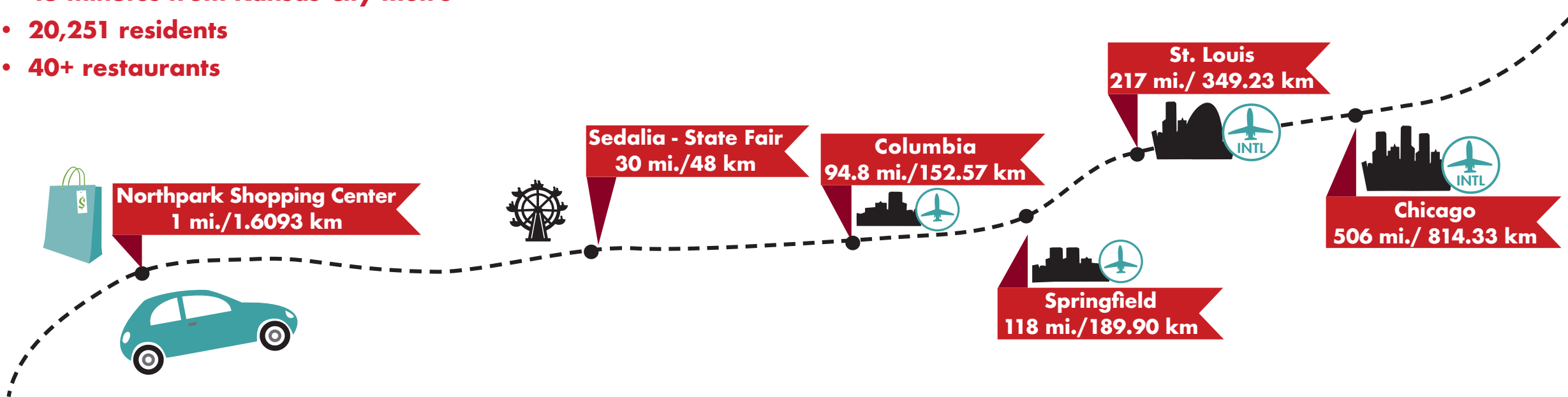
DISTANCES FROM UCM



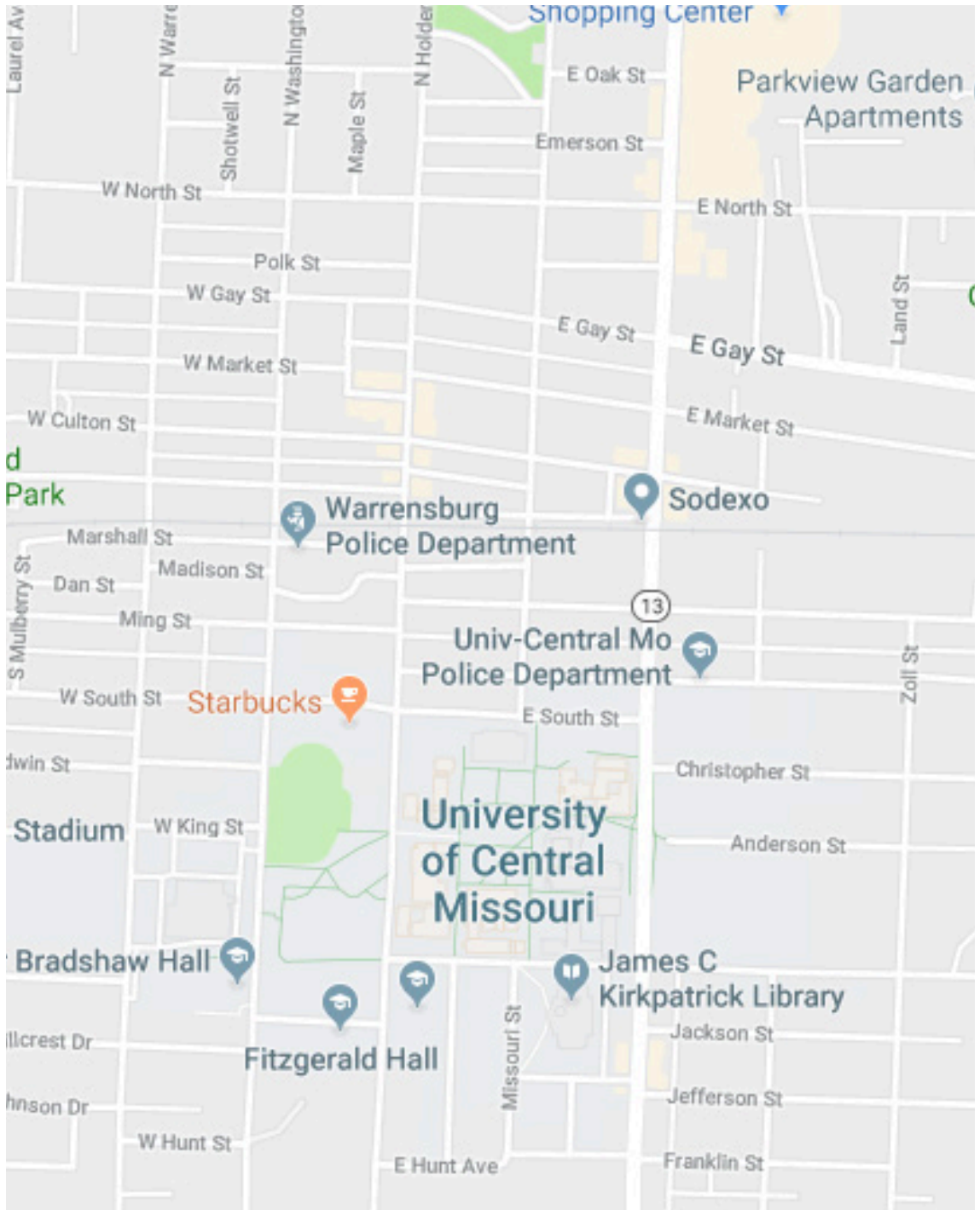
